

MINUTES
CITY OF TARPON SPRINGS PUBLIC ART COMMITTEE
February 16, 2010

The Tarpon Springs Public Art Committee (PAC) met in the Tarpon Springs Public Library Conference Room on Tuesday, February 16, 2010 with members Marleen Gravitz, Mic Poppa, Barbara Schnipper, and Beverly Kurpinski present. Also present were Assistant City Attorney Shauna Morris, City Advisor Ginny Haller, City Liaison Denise Manning, and regular guest, Vice Mayor Robin Saenger. Board members Sue Geier, June Fox, and Maria Bobotas were absent as was Director of Cultural and Civic Services Kathy Monahan.

Chairperson Marleen Gravitz called the meeting to order at 10:05 am. The minutes from the meeting of January 26, 2010 were approved as read, with an amendment stating that Shauna Morris would rewrite a section of the PAC General Guidelines. Barbara Schnipper moved to accept, seconded by Mic Poppa; all were in favor.

Presentations scheduled by Sue Geier on the welcome mat project and by Kathy Monahan on public art grant availability will be rescheduled for the next PAC meeting on Tuesday, March, 16, 2010 due to their absence at this meeting.

Shauna Morris discussed design elements presented for the Wayfinder and Signage Project. Ms. Morris stated that PAC member(s) should attend future signage meetings to provide input and assist with design selection.

PAC General Guidelines were reviewed and revised from the middle of page 22 through the top of page 26. Additional sections of the guidelines will be rewritten in future PAC meetings to address communication issues, material and color specifications from artists, and PAC database requirements.

Barbara Schnipper made a motion to adjourn the meeting at 11:51 a.m., Beverly Kurpinski seconded the motion; all were in favor.
