JURY FOR CONSIDERATION OF ARTWORK DONATION
Minutes – October 19, 2010

Members of the Tarpon Springs Public Art Committee, acting as Jury for Consideration of an artwork donation to the City, met in the Tarpon Springs Library Conference Room on Tuesday, October 19, 2010 with Marleen Gravitz, Barbara Schnipper, Mic Poppa, Lynn Pierson, Maria Bobotas, and Georgia Post present. Also present were Director of Cultural and Civic Services Kathy Monahan, City Liaison to the TSPAC Denise Manning, and Vice Mayor Robin Saenger.

It was the consensus of the Jury that artist Leonard Lewis captured the feeling of Sunset Beach in his acrylic painting of the new Beach pavilion.

Due to the nature of the artwork, it was decided that the ten-percent-of-value maintenance fee dictated by the General Guidelines is not necessary in this case. A letter of intent as specified in the General Guidelines must be received from the artist before the November 2nd Board of Commissioners meeting at which time the painting will be gifted to the City. The artwork will be hung at the Community Center on Walton Avenue. Maria Bobotas moved to accept the artwork and waive the maintenance fee contingent upon receipt of the letter of intent; Lynn Pierson seconded the motion; all were in favor.

Maria Bobotas moved to adjourn the Jury meeting at 11:25 am; Barbara Schnipper seconded the motion; all were in favor.
