

City of Tarpon Springs Issues Voluntary Reclaimed Water Usage Restrictions

Effective: May 26, 2011 until further notice

The City of Tarpon Springs has announced that Phase II reclaimed water usage restrictions effective immediately due to continued drought conditions and extremely high demand.

Phase II reclaimed water customers of the City of Tarpon Springs are requested to voluntarily reduce the usage of reclaimed water to two days per week and to only water after 4PM and before 10AM to maximize the effectiveness of irrigation. The City will be performing limited shut-downs of the reclaimed water service system to assist in maintaining supply on an as needed basis

Conservation of reclaimed water will help to ensure that reclaimed water service remains available as much as possible during periods of lack of rainfall and increased irrigation demand. Such conditions are expected to remain in place for approximately the next 4-6 weeks until our normal rainy season begins.

If Phase II restrictions do not provide the required demand relief, the City may implement Phase III restrictions of the reclaimed water program which include mandatory limited watering.

We appreciate the cooperation and understanding of our customers in conserving our limited reclaimed water supply.
