

**CITY OF TARPON SPRINGS SEEKS QUALIFIED VOLUNTEERS FOR SERVICE ON  
CIVIL SERVICE BOARD**

The City of Tarpon Springs, Florida, is seeking applicants for service on the City's Civil Service Board. Civil Service Board members are volunteers that are appointed by the City Commission for two (2) year terms. The Civil Service Board's mission is to conduct fair hearings for appeals concerning employment matters by non-exempt permanent employees. Board members are also called upon to observe examinations to ensure that they are conducted fairly and impartially.

To be qualified for consideration, applicants must:

- Not be a current employee of the City in any capacity or have been employed by the City within the past 5 years;
- Be a qualified elector of the City of Tarpon Springs
- Have been a continuous resident of the City of Tarpon Springs for no less than 1 year prior to appointment
- Not be related to a current City employee (within the degree set forth in the anti-nepotism provisions of Chapter 112 FS)
