

Public Notice –Reclaimed Water Usage Restrictions being Eased to Phase I

Please be advised that due to the recent rainfall, the City of Tarpon Springs is easing restrictions to **Phase I reclaimed water usage restrictions** effective immediately. This means that we continue to request customers to limit watering with reclaimed to 2 days per week and the City anticipates limited interruptions in service provided regular rainfall continues.

The restriction phases are described in the table below. The conservation of our reclaimed water will help ensure that reclaimed water service remains available as much as possible.

Reclaimed Water Restriction Phased Plan

Phase I	<i>Voluntarily</i> reducing reclaimed water usage to 2 days per week outside of the hours of 10 am to 4 pm to maximize the effectiveness of irrigation
Phase II	<i>Voluntarily</i> reducing reclaimed water usage to 2 days per week outside of the hours of 10 am to 4 pm to maximize the effectiveness of irrigation & <i>Mandatory</i> interruptions of service as needed during the hours of 10 am to 4 pm to minimize waste from evaporation and assist in maintaining supply
Phase III	<i>Mandatory</i> limited watering days citywide, with interruptions in service as required to restore supply. <i>Reclaimed water service will only be available on Saturday, Tuesday and Thursday from 12:01 am to 11:59 pm.</i> If drought conditions persist and reclaimed water supply is not sufficient, additional off days will be required.

We greatly appreciate your assistance in conserving our important but limited reclaimed water supply.
