



REQUEST FOR TEMPORARY UNDER GROUND POWER (TUG)

In consideration for authorizing the utility company to energize the facility, we agree with and understand the following:

1. This Tug application is valid only for one-and two-family dwellings.
2. The building will not be occupied until certificate of occupancy has been issued. I/We understand that if the building is occupied before a certificate of occupancy has been issued the Building Official will have the right to direct the utility to terminate electrical service without notice. Furthermore, I/We understand and agree that should the Building Official exercise such right, the City of Tarpon Springs will not be responsible for any damage or cost which may result from the exercise of such right. Also, in the event any third party claims damage from the exercise of such right, I/We agree to jointly and individually indemnify and hold harmless the City of Tarpon Springs from all such damages and cost, including attorney's fees.
3. Prior to final power, the building or structure shall be weather tight and secure. The electrical equipment and wiring to be energized will be 100% complete and approved by the inspector prior to being energized. The rest of the wiring and electrical system shall be in safe order. The electrical service will be 100% complete unless specifically approved by the electrical inspector.
4. Interior electrical rooms shall be lockable. If electrical panels are in an area that cannot be locked by doors, the panels shall be equipped with a locking mechanism (approved by the AHJ). The licensed electrical contractor or his representative shall hold the keys(s) for such access to electrical panels to prevent energizing circuits other than those that are safe.
5. TUG approval is for service and outside GFCI receptacles only. No equipment inside the building is permitted to be energized.
6. Permanent service must be installed on structure, service must be properly grounded and surge arrestor must be installed, and service panel must be protected from weather and physical damage.
