

## **Palm Avenue Drainage Improvements**

## **ATTENTION RESIDENTS & BUSINESSES**

The City of Tarpon Springs, Public Works Department will be commencing with the Palm Avenue Drainage Improvement project. This Capital Improvement Project is intended to decrease localized flooding and provide water quality improvement in your area. (*See Project Map below*) The Project is planned to begin early April 2020, lasting for approximately 6 months.

As part of the City's on-going stormwater capital improvement projects associated with its Stormwater Action Plan (SAP), the City's Public Works Department has partnered with the Southwest Florida Water Management District on a stormwater flood protection and water quality improvement project. The project involves installing a new stormwater collection system along Palm Avenue, Tarpon Drive and include the construction of a new stormwater management facility. The stormwater improvement project aims to reduce the historic and frequent flooding within the area. The



construction of a new stormwater management facility (pond) will also provide additional water quality treatment for adjacent waterbodies.

The City will provide additional information accordingly as the project progresses.
