Information Regarding Spruce Street Extension Project

Dear Residents:

This courtesy letter is to provide pertinent information to those City residents living along the Spruce Street project extents. To briefly summarize, the project consists of extending/installing the asphalt-paved Spruce Street roadway eastward from U.S. Highway 19 to Jasmine Street. Related stormwater improvements along with a pedestrian sidewalk and a new drinking water pipe with new service connections are also included within the project. An aerial photo showing the approximate project extents is provided below.



City Staff recently held a pre-construction meeting with the project engineers and contractor and would like to summarize some points of discussion that would be of interest:

- One of the City's priorities will be to work closely with the contractor during construction to minimize disruption to your daily life.
- Initial construction will begin shortly with installation of erosion control barriers (silt fences).
- At all times site access will be maintained to provide local traffic access.
- All utilities will be maintained during construction. The new drinking water pipe will be installed concurrently during the road/sidewalk phase.
- Construction duration will about seven months, resulting in an estimated project completion during the summer of 2018.
