

Items like wipes, cotton balls, and dental floss may be labelled as "flushable", but they are not. These items do not break down like toilet paper in the wastewater system and cause clogs to form. These clogs will grow to create back-ups and overflows throughout the wastewater system.

Do Not Flush:

- Baby and/or adult cleaning wipes
- Medication
- Dental floss
- Cotton swabs and balls
- Feminine hygiene products (maxi pads, tampons, & wrappers)
- Bandages
- Kitty litter
- Paper towels
- Hair

Also, please note that clogs within sanitary sewer piping (sewer lateral) on the homeowner's property are the homeowner's responsibility.
