

Tarpon Springs Splash Park

PARK RULES

- THE PARK IS LIMITED TO FAMILY USE ONLY (buses and organized groups prohibited)
- USERS MUST BE FROM 2 TO 12 YEARS OF AGE, MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A PARENT OR ADULT GUARDIAN and NO ADULTS ALLOWED WITHOUT A CHILD
- USE SPLASH PARK AT YOUR OWN RISK. PARK IS NOT SUPERVISED. NO LIFE-GUARD ON DUTY
- NO GLASS, FOOD OR BEVERAGES (EXCEPT WATER) INSIDE THE FENCED AREA
- NO ANIMALS INSIDE THE FENCED AREA (EXCEPT CERTIFIED GUIDE DOGS FOR THE LEGALLY BLIND)
- USERS MUST SHOWER BEFORE ENTERING THE FENCED SPLASH AREA
- DO NOT USE THE SPLASH PARK IF YOU HAVE INFECTIOUS DISEASES OR OPEN WOUNDS OR ARE ILL WITH DIARRHEA
- DO NOT DRINK THE WATER IT IS "RECIRCULATED" (NOT TO BE CONFUSED WITH RECLAIMED)
- BATHING LOAD: 90 PERSONS
- The City of Tarpon Springs is not responsible for lost or stolen articles.
- Running, roughness, horseplay and other disturbances are prohibited.
- Do not climb, hang, swing or pull on the Splash Park equipment.
- No pool toys or floats are permitted inside the Splash Park.
- Children that are not toilet trained must wear a swim diaper.
- The Splash Park is for recreational use only. No bathing permitted.
- Water shoes or sandals are recommended. Street shoes are not permitted within the Splash Park.
- No skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles or scooters permitted in the Splash Park. Strollers, walkers and wheelchairs are permitted.
