As you know Tarpon Springs Little League is a volunteer run not for profit organization with the goal of providing a fun and educational baseball and softball experience for the Tarpon Springs youth.

If the League were to be able to not pay the monthly field use age fees, the League would be able to continue to keep the season fees down for our local youth. Currently we are one of the lowest in Pinellas County. The league would be able to replace equipment, baseballs and softballs and continue to improve the experience for our local youth.

On average our league pays the city approximately \$850.00 a month. While this may seem like a small amount, the budget of the league is dependent upon registration dues and sponsorship to stay afloat, pay Little League dues and Insurance, uniforms and equipment.

If the City were able to forgo field use age fees, the entire Tarpon Springs Little League, Board of Directors and membership would be extremely great full.
