Jitney Garage: Research is ongoing for alternative (lower) priced options for this project.

Semaphore Railroad Arm: Three quotes have been received for this renovation project. We are proceeding to Procurement phase to finalize the contract and award the project. Work is currently estimated to begin by the end of April.

Re: Downtown Lights


The last few years the supply chain has hindered our access to obtaining acorn lights that we use downtown. Lights that were purchased were used to replace existing damaged lights in the CRA District.

Before we can add additional lights, the City's electrical service will need to be updated to meet additional loads. Improvements to the system will include panel boxes, drops, conduits, wiring and extensive concrete work. The estimated cost will be approximately \$100,000, not including the cost of the lights.

We are looking for some alternatives at a lower price than \$100,000 to assist with better lighting. We will report on these at the next CRA meeting.



Spring Bayou/West Tarpon Property - What is your TOP choice for this property?





Spring Bayou/West Tarpon Property - Which would be your SECOND choice for this property?





Spring Bayou/West Tarpon Property - If this property were DEVELOPED, which type would be your PREFERRED choice?





Bayou Gardens: A wedding venue

Why not take advantage of what is already happening at Spring Bayou and capitalize o n it? Convert the building into a commercial kitchen and landscape the grounds with lo vely flowers and brick patios, and use it as a place to set up cocktail-type wedding rece ptions. The town could set up strict rules regarding hours, size, parking, bands (ie: no a mplifiers, less than "X" amount of decibels). A policeman would be required for traffic c ontrol. On top of the fee for the facility, the customer would pay for caterers, cleaning, re ntal furniture, tent (if necessary) dishes, flatware, glassware, flowers, alcohol and barte nder with insurance, any permit required by the town, trash removal, etc. Hire a part-ti me manager who is in charge of the facility, including tours for potential use, working wi th caterers, enforcing rules and ensuring caterers leave the venue spotless. Charge Ta rpon residents a small fee (plus costs) and out-of-town residents pay a premium and m ust be sponsored by a full time resident. Number of weddings per weekend are limited as are the number per year. The manager would be paid from the earnings. When not being used for weddings, the facility is available for town organizations for free or a sm all fee (as long as they follow the rules and leave the place spotless - offenders are not allowed to return for 1 year). Residents may rent the facility for proms, birthday parties, first communions, etc. The initial investment (commercial kitchen, landscaping, marketi ng materials (website, brochures, attendance at wedding fairs, etc.), manager, would b e easily returned within the first year (as long as the effort was put into marketing.) This works in other places. (check out The Pierce House owned by the Town of Lincoln, Ma ssachusetts: http://box2030.temp.domains/~pierceh3/?page_id=24) The manager coul d also take on the coordination of ceremonies being held at the bayou - adding addition al income by charging for use (or at the very least, a permit). This has the potential for significant return for the town.
