### **RESOLUTION No. 2001-22**

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF TARPON SPRINGS, FLORIDA FINDING THAT, WITHIN THE DOWNTOWN, A BLIGHTED AREA EXISTS IN THAT AREA GENERALLY SURROUNDING PINELLAS AVENUE AND TARPON AVENUE AND BEING LEGALLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; FINDING THAT THE REHABILITATION, CONSERVATION, REDEVELOPMENT OR A COMBINATION THEREOF OF THE SUBJECT AREA IS NECESSARY; FINDING A NEED FOR A COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY TO BE CREATED TO CARRY OUT REDEVELOPMENT ACTIVITIES WITHIN SAID BLIGHTED AREA; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, on December 12, 2000 the Board of Commissioners adopted the Downtown Development Action Plan (DDAP) prepared by RMPK Assocs. in consultation with the Strategic Planning Group, Tindale-Oliver and Assocs., governmental agencies and stakeholders in the affected area; and,

**WHEREAS**, the purpose of the DDAP is to devise strategies that will resolve the physical and functional problems of the Downtown; and,

WHEREAS, the implementation strategy of the DDAP is based, in large part, upon the creation of a Community Redevelopment Agency to guide and fund public infrastructure improvements that will foster private investment in new development and renovation; and.

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Department has conducted a study to determine if the subject area meets the criteria of Chap. 163.340 and contains one or more blighted areas; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners finds that there exists within the subject area certain conditions creating a blighted area within the meaning of the Community Redevelopment Act of 1969; and

WHEREAS, written and published legal notice of the adoption of this Resolution has been provided pursuant to Chap. 163.346, F.S.

### NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF TARPON SPRINGS, FLORIDA:

### Section 1. FINDING OF NECESSITY

a) The Board of Commissioners does hereby find that a blighted area, as defined by Chapter 163.340, Florida Statutes, exists within the City of Tarpon Springs in the area described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein.

b) The rehabilitation, conservation, or redevelopment, or a combination thereof, of this blighted area is necessary in the interest of the public health, safety, morals and welfare of the residents of Tarpon Springs.

### Section 2. NEED FOR CRA

The Board of Commissioners further finds and determines that, as a consequence of finding that a blighted area exists and the necessity for its rehabilitation, conservation or redevelopment, a need exists for the creation of a community redevelopment agency for the purpose of rehabilitating the blighted area.

### Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE

This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.

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
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
