SUBJECT: Bayshore Sewer Project, Next Steps

Thank you to those of you who attended the meeting with staff on Monday, May 6, 2024, and/or the Board of Commissioners meeting on Tuesday, May 7, 2024, presenting your concerns. I want to assure you that we have heard your concerns and will work to address them if possible and as best as we can. This includes but is not limited to:

- potential grant opportunities for homeowners
- grinder pump alternative configuration options
- alternatives such as on-site private treatment systems (Distributed Wastewater Treatment Systems, or DWTS)
- researching mandatory connection options
- analysis of any other assistance options for residents

I have directed my staff to review all information and concerns raised by you and your neighbors, to provide you with additional information, and to hold future meetings with individuals and groups of residents.

However, the City has an active construction contract underway, and we must continue with the construction of the pipeline work to avoid significant delays. Though you may see workers tidying up and doing minor activities, we have put the construction project on hold for a few days to research your comments and verify the technical aspects and engineering that was completed to validate the Low-Pressure Sewer System (LPSS) recommendation and confirm the limitations regarding gravity sewers in this area. Unless the research indicates otherwise, the contractor will be instructed to continue construction of the pipeline in the City right-of-way while we work through the issues and options that are summarized in the list above.

Finally, City staff has posted the 2022 alternatives analysis for this project area which indicates very limited options for sewer installations in this part of town.
