Here is a summary of the Florida Water Quality Improvement Grant application status for the Bayshore Septic-to-Sewer Project. I will post this update on the project website.

Grant Application Submitted: May 23, 2024

Amount Requested: \$550,000

Grant Purpose: To establish a residential rebate program to help customers offset the costs of grinder pumps to connect to the City's Low Pressure Sewer System. Of the total amount of the grant, 100% would be allocated towards the customer rebate program.

Grant Timeline: Grant award dates can vary year to year. Last year's award was announced in December 2023.
